

KEY SELLING POINTS

Thousands of Swedish women share the country's most popular name – Anna Andersson. Besides their name and nationality, do they have anything else in common? In 2014, photographer Meredith Andrews travelled the length of Sweden to find out. From a tattoo artist to a priest, a child to a 99-year old, Meredith found astonishing diversity within this statistically significant group of women who all answer to the same name.

01 Who is Anna Andersson? is the first-ever book by portrait and editorial photographer Meredith Andrews.

02 It is the first book to explore popular local naming conventions and preconceptions using photography.

03 By featuring portraits of women that share country's most common name, the book also provides a visual impression of contemporary Sweden.

04 Instead of using a studio, Meredith goes on location into the women's homes and lives to offer deeper insight into who they really are and their place in Swedish society.

05 Meredith's background as a storyteller is evident in her pictures. The dramatic natural light and rich details reveal greater significance every time you look.

06 Her approach elevates the stories of 'ordinary' women, proving that everyday subjects are often more intriguing than people in the public eye.

07 The collected portraits appeal to readers' increasing interest in real people and real situations. The editorial style creates a feeling of a private connection to someone you have never met.

08 Each Anna Andersson is accompanied by a short text that offers readers a glimpse of their personalities, interests and ambitions.

09 As a foreigner living in Sweden, Meredith uses her outsider's perspective to her advantage, capturing the essence of what sets the country and its residents apart.

10 Who is Anna Andersson? is only the beginning. It is the first book is a series that will continue to explore naming conventions and national identity in a variety of countries.
